#### EXPLAINING CPD

Continuing Professional Development (CPD) is a requirement of many professional bodies and the focus of this seminar. Most professional organisations, including the Planning Institute of Australia, the Australian Institute of Architects, and the Architects Registration Board of NSW, have differential point allocations depending on the degree of engagement of the audience. Under the programs of the AIA and ARB of NSW, this seminar counts as 4 informal hours and, if the take-home assignment is completed, as 6 formal hours. For PIA members, attendance at the full day seminar counts for 6 informal points. With the completed take home assignment, it is worth 12 formal points. Members of other organisations should contact their relevant professional body regarding credits.

#### FORMAL ASSESSMENT TASK

Prepare a short, 400-500 word commentary (not a synopsis) for each of the two sessions of the seminar: morning and afternoon. You may choose any format, including point form notes. We expect this task may take 30-45 minutes per session to complete.
